

A surviving spouse does **not** automatically remain a member of the CN Pensioners Association. To remain a member of the Belleville Council, the surviving spouse must complete a new membership application and arrange their own payment of dues (\$1.00 per month).

In the last newsletter, Spring 2023 Edition (May), you probably noticed that the Renfrew Subdivision was pictured.

It was taken from **Canadian National Railway** Time Table 12 St Lawrence Region-Rideau Area taking effect at 0001 Sunday, October 30, 1966.

TT No.12 also showed the Marmora Subdivision running from *Picton* to *Lake St. Peter.* The previous Time Table, No.11, taking effect at 12.01 A.M. Sunday, April 24, 1966. does not show a Marmora Subdivision. Instead, it shows the Picton Subdivision running from *Picton* to *Trenton Yard* as well as the Maynooth Subdivision running from *Trenton Yard* to *Lake St. Peter.* 

How come? What happened? Does anyone know what led to this change and to what purpose?


